DRESS CODE

As in every area of our lives, clothing and the way we wear it should represent our desire to please God and honor Him.

1 Peter 3:4 ESV: But let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious.

The following dress code is set forth in the interest of good grooming, modesty and sound educational practices.

No shirts, hoodies, or facemasks with writing and/or images that would not be aligned with godly principles. During periods of elections, students are asked to refrain from political attire.

All clothing must be clean and in good repair. No ripped, torn, or frayed clothing.

Hats should NOT be worn inside the building.

Clothing that is excessively tight is not appropriate.

Tops must have wide straps (no spaghetti straps) and must completely cover the torso at all times.

Students may wear nice jeans, shorts (no shorter than mid-thigh), and athletic shorts and pants.

Dress shoes, athletic shoes, and sandals are acceptable. Slides and crocs may be worn with the understanding that they may be a safety issue.

Hair must be clean and neatly groomed. Facial hair should be neatly groomed.

Ear piercing is acceptable; however, earrings should not be a distraction. All facial and visible body piercings are unacceptable. Visible tattoos and body art are also unacceptable.

It is the parents' responsibility to ensure that their students are in complete compliance with the school's dress code standards. Students may not attend class unless dress code guidelines are met. Should a student arrive at school out of compliance, it may be necessary for the student's parents to bring appropriate clothing so the student may attend class. Repeated offenses may result in further disciplinary action.
